CASE STUDY: Rockcliffe Hall Hotel



EndoTherm has been trialled at Rockcliffe Hall Hotel in Hurworth on Tees, Darlington.

To present a business case to the owners of Rockcliffe Hall Hotel a small trial was run in a 12 bedroom accomodation block which is situated (and heated) seperately to the main building.

The site is heated using a large domestic boiler and distributed using radiators. Occupancy of this block remains consistent throughout the year.

The management team at Rockcliffe Hall provided the monthly meter readings for April which was compared with March and Feb previously in 2017 and against all 3 months in 2016.

Compensated Saving 15.01%

During the first month the trial saved £35 (3p/kWh) and 215kg CO₂ (0.184kg CO₂ per kWh).
